Hey key clubbers!

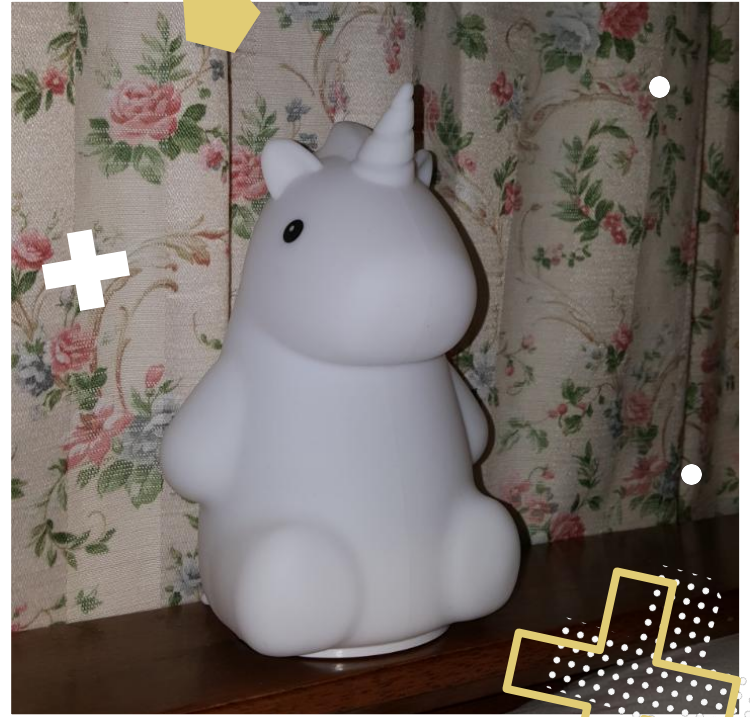
