



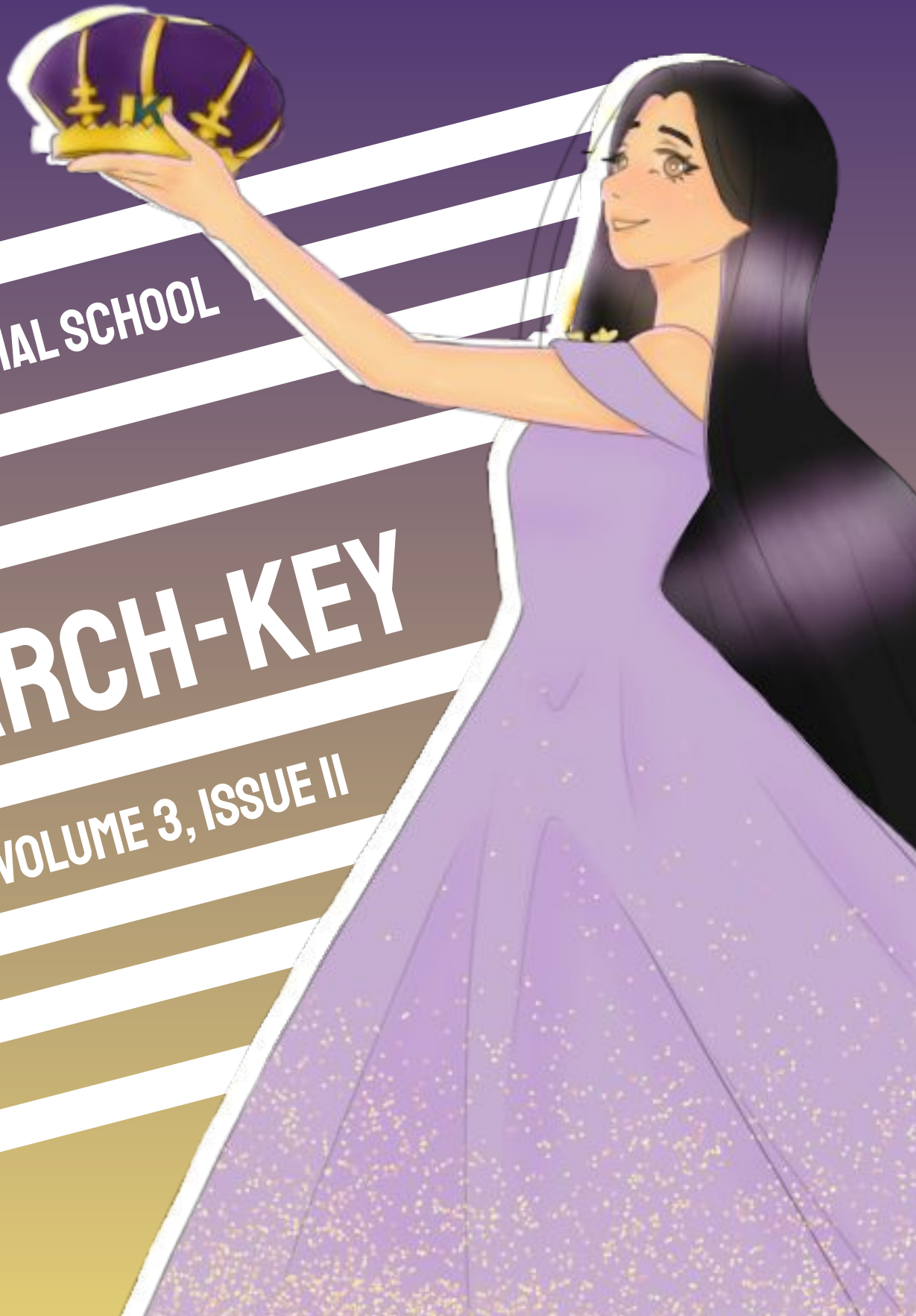

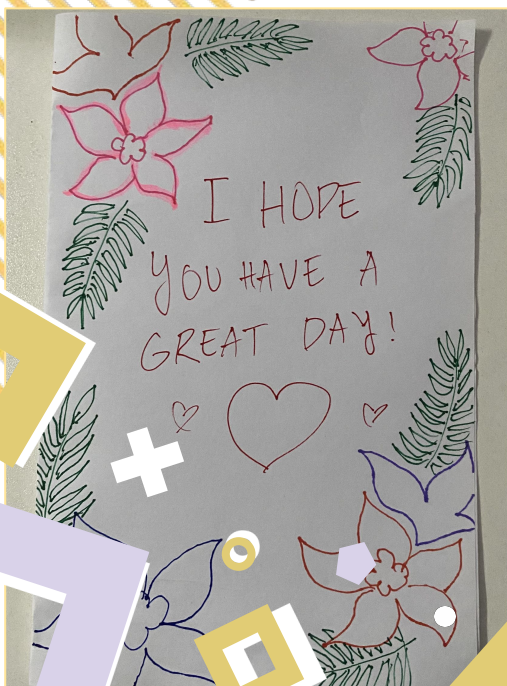
I don't have much else to say, so I'll end my message here. Stay safe and I hope to see some of y'all at any upcoming Key Club events! :D





# LOVE FOR OUR ELDERERS

From the beginning of the pandemic, many people—especially the elderly—have remained socially isolated in order to ensure their health and safety seeing as they are part of the most vulnerable group. As a result, many have begun to feel lonely. With this as a driving factor, an organization was created to share love to elderly who need support through the distribution of letters. Damien Memorial key Club members created handwritten letters using any type of paper, writing utensil, and coloring utensils to decorate their creation. Keeping in mind of



what is not allowed in these letters, members conveyed their words of kindness, sharing love and inspiration to the elderly who will be sent these letters through the organization. Seeing as the organization is based in Ohio, members mailed their letters there to be shared with the elderly.

'Rice Race' is a mobile game that can be downloaded from the app store created with the intention of aiding in the cause to end global hunger. In a playing style similar to that of 'Flappy Bird' or Mario, the protagonist of Rice Race takes on the form of a penguin using a balloon as transportation. The penguin runs, jumps, and flies while avoiding a multitude of different types of obstacles all while, at the same, completing its objective of collection as many grains of rice as one can. The mobile app uses its in-game ads to make donations. Members of Damien Key Club, in a friendly competition with Alaka'i Young Professionals, collectively downloaded the app and collected over 10,000 grains of rice in total, helping to participate in the mission to end global hunger.

# CRANES FOR CANCER



Deriving from the Japanese words “ori”, which means folding, and “kami”, which means paper, origami is literally the art of paper-folding. Through the folding of square sheets of paper, one is able to fold sculptures of all sorts such as hearts, flowers, butterflies, swans, and more importantly, cranes. Folding 1,000 cranes is said to allow one a wish to be granted by the sacred crane. Because of this, cranes are often gifted to those who may be ill. As such, many have begun to gift 1,000 cranes to hospital patients. Cranes for Cancer is a small organization that is based around this idea. Cranes from all over are sent to them to be distributed in boxes of 1,000s to cancer patients to “bring hope and uplift spirits”. Damien Memorial Key Club was able to fold over 1,000 cranes in total to donate to the organization.
