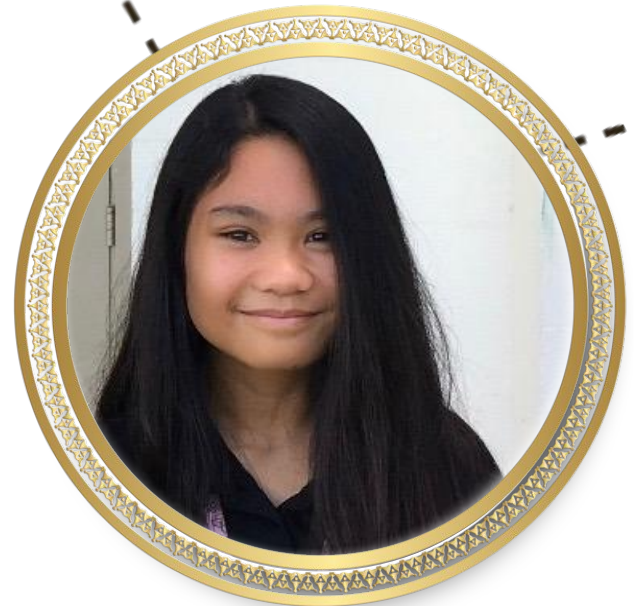

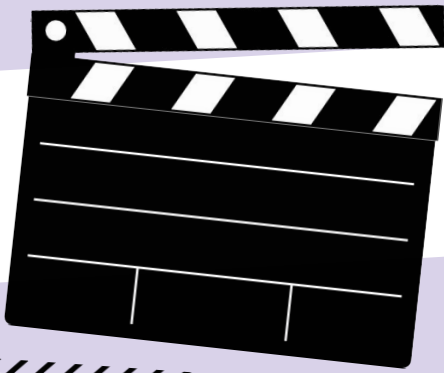
## SECRETARY'S LETTER

## CHRISTINE NGUYEN: CLASS OF 2021 DIRECTOR



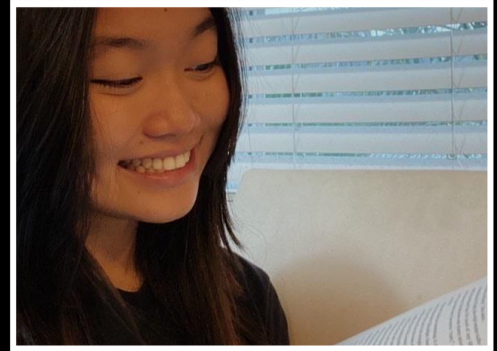

6. Wear washable masks when going shopping.



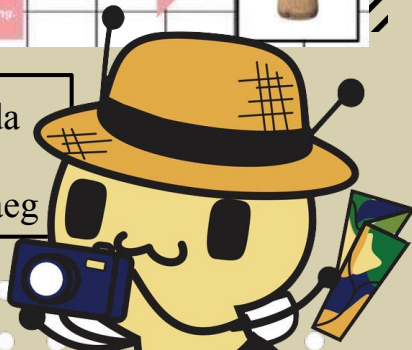
