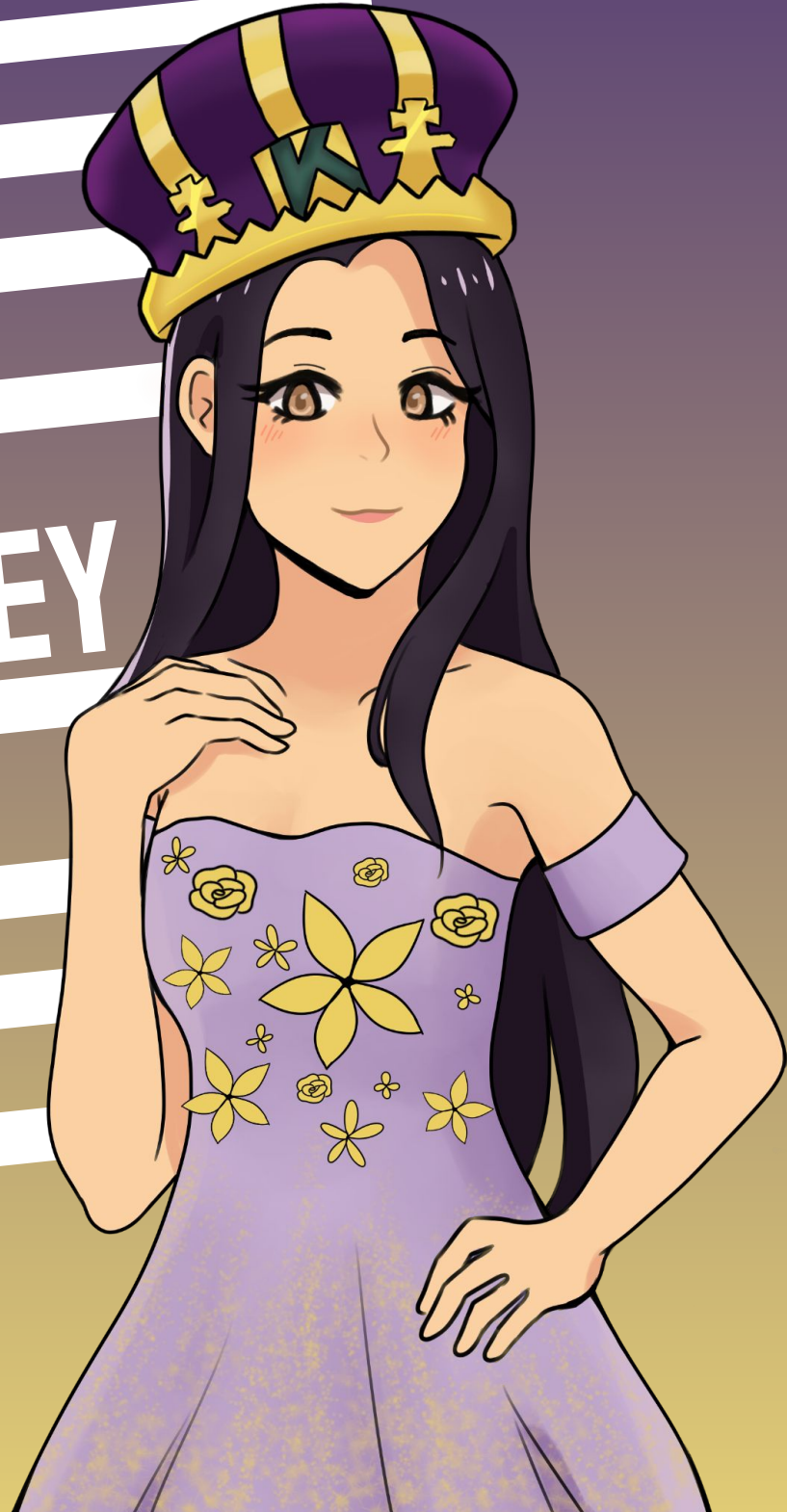

EDITOR'S NOTE

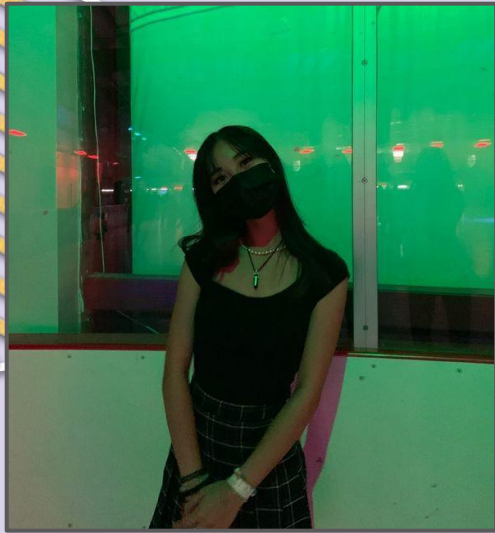

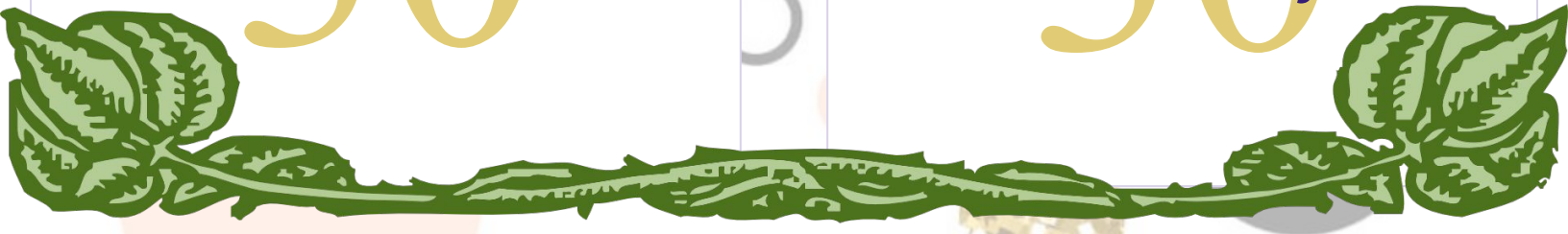
