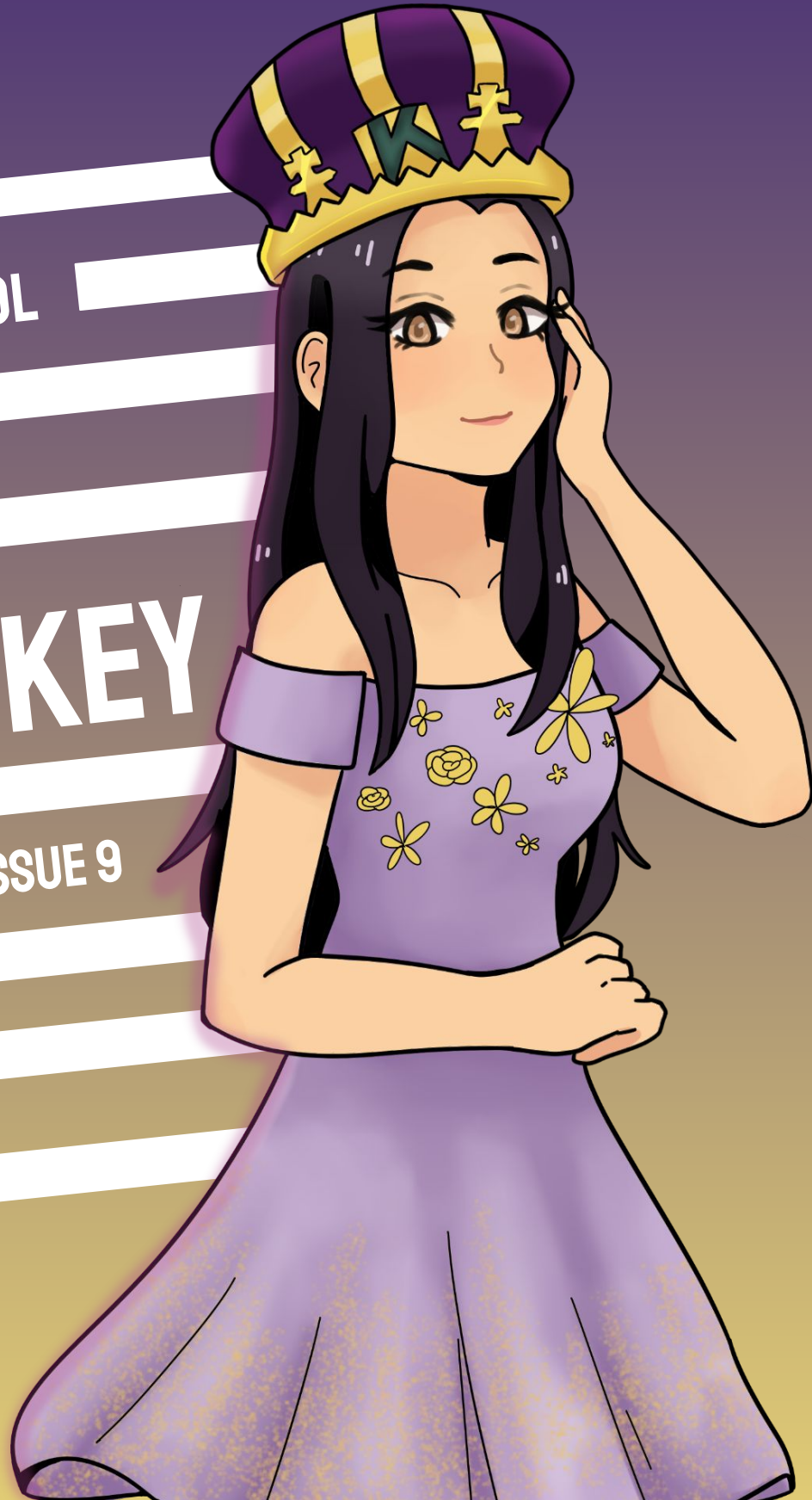

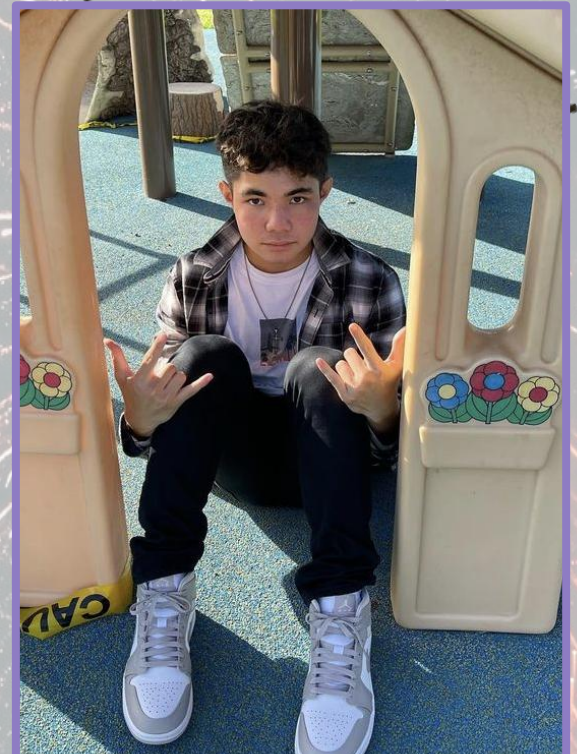

EDITOR'S NOTE

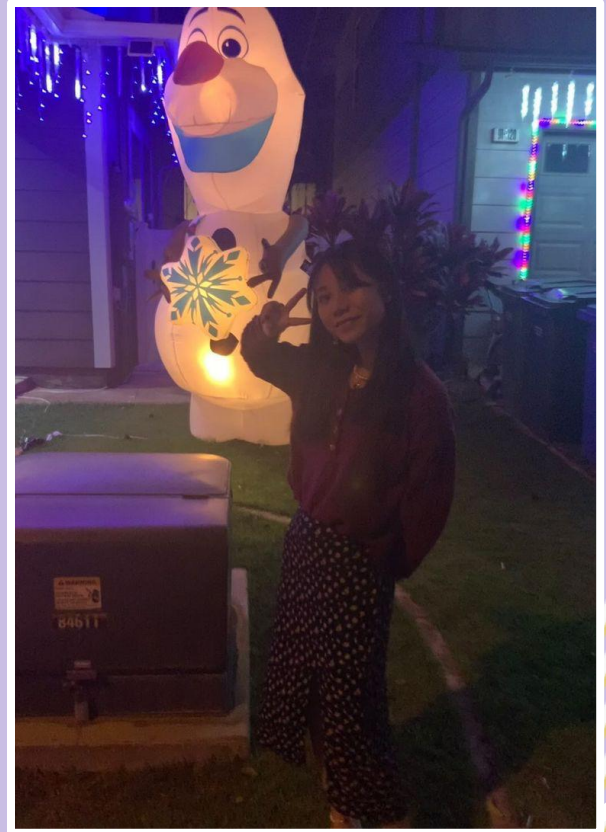

JANUARY MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

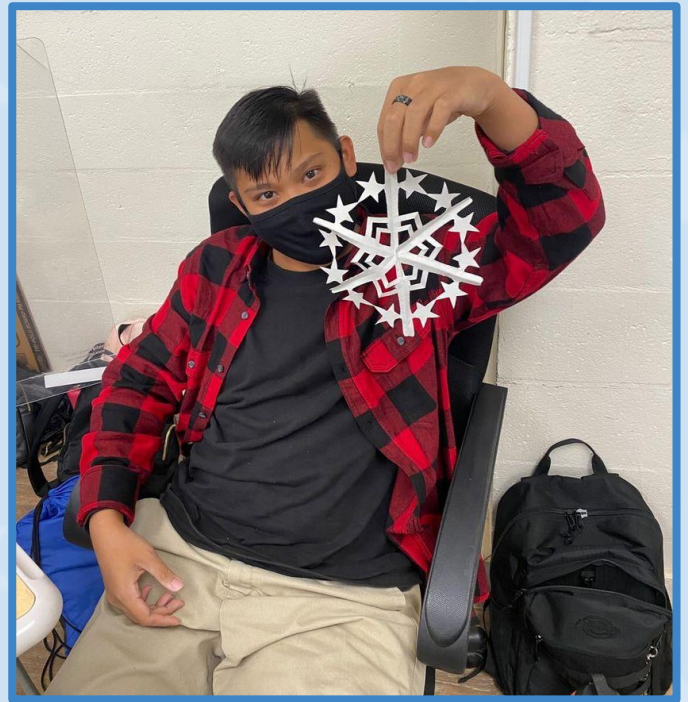

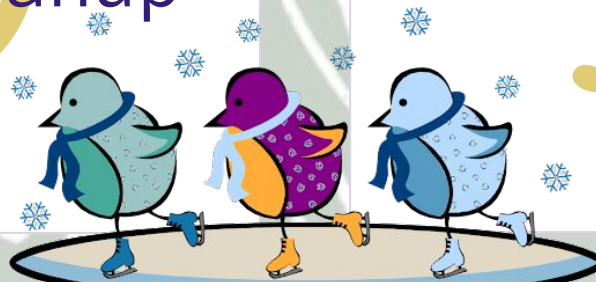
