


TREES FOR KAIMUKI




On Saturday, April 16, 2022, Damien Memorial Key Club members. teamed up with Damien Memorial National Honor Society and the Diamond Head State Monument to participate in their Trees for Kaimuki event: a community-led project, supported by the City and County, to increase the urban canopy in Kaimuki and ultimately mitigate the effects of climate change. At this project, members from both Damien Memorial and the Bank of Hawaii met up inside Kapi'olani Community College's white gates and started with their first task of mulching to improve the soil moisture, fertility, and health of the trees in the area. After mulching, members trimmed the canopies and trunks of the trees, reducing stress on the trees. Lastly, members finished up the project with a trivia session hosted by the Diamond Head staff and had the fun opportunity to win stickers as prizes for their correct answers.

WAIMEA VALLEY VOLUNTEERING



This month, Damien Memorial Key Club members participated in a new service project: the Waimea Valley Volunteering Program. For this project, members showed up to verdant Waimea Valley located on the North Shore on Sunday, April 24, 2022 from 9 AM to 12:30 PM and got to work on the park's main botanical garden. At the beginning of the project, the Waimea Valley staff chanted the "E O Mai" over Damien's members in order to prepare them for entering and cultivating the sacred space. They were also taught about the five senses in 'Olelo Hawai'i! Then, they were led into the park, where most members cleared out pond weeds and binding vines from the land in the area for the majority of the 3 hours, while others dug out dead trees. As the project neared its end, members gained access into the park, and they were allowed to roam the park and swim in the waterfall for free!
